
Is it a sin to use God's name in profanity?

Profanity is obscene, vulgar language that may or may not include God's name. People may thoughtlessly ask God to condemn a person or a thing in their profanity, but if questioned, admit that they did not mean it literally. They say their angry words were not intended to deliberately ask God to harm someone and deliberate intent is one requirement for what constitutes a sin. God who knows our hearts can determine if our misuse of his name is a form of venting, but the Second Commandment warns us that taking the Lord's name in vain does not please him, even if no harm to another is intended. The danger in constantly and carelessly using God's holy name profanely is that over time we can easily become desensitized to the practice, creating an irreverent attitude toward God that is offensive and may lead others into sin.

Recall that when we pray, "Hallowed be thy name" in the Lord's Prayer—the prayer Jesus taught his disciples—we ask God to enable us to give him the reverence that is due; it comes first before we ask anything for ourselves—a sure sign of our respect for God.

Because God's name is holy, we mustn't abuse it. Despite the erosion of inhibitions against poor word choices in our time, consider this prayerful petition from the last verse of Psalm 19: "Let the words of my mouth be acceptable, / the thoughts of my heart before you, / LORD, my rock and my redeemer." ●

Musimy przyznać, że bez Ducha Świętego jesteśmy niczym. Potrzebujemy Ducha Bożego. Duch świadczy o Chrystusie przed uczniami, a przez nich – przed światem. Tak chce działać przez nas. „Jeszcze wiele mam wam do powiedzenia, ale teraz [jeszcze] znieść nie możecie”. Jezus przypomina im, że nie są gotowi na przyjęcie wszystkiego, co On chce im dać. Teraz, w tym momencie, nie są gotowi do zrozumienia całej treści wiary. Niektóre rzeczy zrozumieją później. Dlatego będą potrzebować pomocy Ducha Bożego. Dar Ducha doprowadzi uczniów do pełnego zrozumienia prawdy, która objawia się w Synu Wcielonym. Jeśli chcemy poznać Syna Bożego, usłyszeć, co nam mówi, postępować we właściwy sposób, żyć mądrze, poznać prawdę o nas, potrzebujemy pomocy Ducha Świętego. Kiedy żyjemy według Ducha Świętego, Bóg jest uwielbiony w nas i przez nas.

Pentecost Sunday

When I was twenty-two years of age in August of 2000, I experienced World Youth Day in Rome. As for many of my generation, the event was life-changing for me. Surrounded by joyful, hope-filled young people from seemingly every nation and tongue, we were gathered around the Pope, sharing a common Faith and love. The Pope spoke to us of our shared family bond in the Church and invited us to give our lives in service to others. Now twenty-four years later, my life as a priest, like that of so many others from those special days, continues on that same path of love and unity — despite my many weaknesses. What makes that continuation possible?

This week's feast gives the answer: the Holy Spirit. The gift of God — His very life — the third person of the Trinity, is the Spirit who animates the entire Church and each member of it. He makes us one-in-love in a way that utterly exceeds human capacity. For example, he makes the apostles speak with tongues of fire, and everyone hears them in his own native tongue. The Holy Spirit is the means by which Jesus establishes a new family, one that crosses all possible boundaries of time, space, and culture. The Holy Spirit never tires in enthusing us for mission. Aren't we longing to experience the Holy Spirit in a fresh way? Today we celebrate this untiring flame, once ignited on earth and burning still. So, we humbly cry out: Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and enkindle in us the fire of your love!


