

Dear Padre

What is spiritual direction? How does it differ from counseling?

In spiritual direction, a person is guided in a process of reflection, self-discovery, and recognition of God's presence in human experience; the primary focus is on one's relationship with God. Thus, in one sense, it is the Lord himself who is the "director" in all spiritual direction. In counseling, a person is also guided in a process of reflection and self-discovery; but the primary focus is on human growth and development. Counseling does not presuppose a person's faith or relationship with God; spiritual direction cannot be complete without it. Both spiritual direction and counseling share the same expectations of openness and honesty in the process; they share the same standards of confidentiality and professional conduct. Moreover, spiritual direction is similar to counseling in its aim toward human growth and development, but it further aims toward holiness and "toward ever more intimate union with Christ" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 2014). That union is twofold: a personal relationship with Christ and with Christ's Church. "This union is called 'mystical' because it participates in the mystery of Christ through the sacraments" (CCC 2014). "All Christians in any state or walk of life are called to the fullness of Christian life and to the perfection of charity. All are called to holiness: 'Be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect'" (CCC 2013). ●

Registración a la Parroquia

Nuestra parroquia tiene el estatus de Parroquia Personal, lo que significa que solo la persona que declara su voluntad de pertenecer a la parroquia es considerado un feligrés.

Todos los domingos, la participación en misas, o el hecho de vivir en la parroquia no es sinónimo de pertenecer a ella.

Además, el hecho de que alguien en nuestra parroquia haya participado en las enseñanzas prematrimoniales, se casó o bautizó a un niño no significa pertenecer automáticamente a la parroquia, porque en nuestra comunidad hay bodas y bautizos de personas de fuera de la parroquia.

Cada feligrés puede recibir varios certificados por medio de Registrarse a una comunidad determinada y organizar todos los trámites relacionados con los sacramentos, por ejemplo:

- El bautismo o el Sacramento del matrimonio.
- Recibir certificados para ser padrino/a de confirmación o testigo/a de boda.
- También pueden recibir permiso para ser bautizados o bautizar a su propio hijo/a en otra parroquia (por ejemplo, en sus respectivos Países)
- Permiso para casarse en otra parroquia.

Mk 9, 30-37 Druga zapowiedź męki i wezwanie do pokory

Jezus i Jego uczniowie przemierzali Galileę, On jednak nie chciał, żeby ktoś o tym wiedział. Pouczał bowiem swoich uczniów i mówił im: «Syn Człowieczy będzie wydany w ręce ludzi. Ci Go zabiją, lecz zabity, po trzech dniach zmartwychwstanie». Oni jednak nie rozumieli tych słów, a bali się Go pytać.

Tak przyszli do Kafarnaum. Gdy był już w domu, zapytał ich: «O czym to rozprawialiście w drodze?» Lecz oni milczeli, w drodze bowiem posprzeczali się między sobą o to, kto z nich jest największy.

On usiadł, przywołał Dwunastu i rzekł do nich: «Jeśli ktoś chce być pierwszym, niech będzie ostatnim ze wszystkich i sługą wszystkich». Potem wziął dziecko, postawił je przed nimi i objąwszy je ramionami, rzekł do nich: «Kto jedno z tych dzieci przyjmuje w imię moje, Mnie przyjmuje; a kto Mnie przyjmuje, nie przyjmuje Mnie, lecz Tego, który Mnie posłał».

Oto słowo Pańskie

Fragment Ewangelii mówi o uczniach dyskutujących między sobą, kto jest największy. Jezus słyszy ich rozmowę. Kiedy przybyli do Kafarnaum, pyta ich, o czym rozmawiali po drodze. Wyjaśniając kwestię pierwszeństwa, Jezus nie mówi: „nie może być wśród was pierwszych!”. Przeciwnie: jeśli ktoś zostaje wybrany na pierwszego, czy też mianowany przywódcą, nie oznacza to, że wszyscy za nim podążają będą Go czcić i Mu służyć. Musi na to zasłużyć swoim przykładem, pracą, jako sługa. To także nowy obraz i idea człowieka – instrukcja Jezusa: „Jeśli ktoś chce być pierwszym, niech będzie ostatnim ze wszystkich i sługą wszystkich” (Mk 9, 35b). Zastanawiam się, gdzie mogę służyć i przyjść na ratunek. Pomóżmy tym, którzy są w potrzebie jakiegokolwiek rodzaju. Prawdziwy sukces to taki, który zapewnia trwałą wartość. Dla trwałych wartości warto żyć i ryzykować życiem. Bądźmy zawsze tymi, którzy dorzymują tych wartości – prawdy, sprawiedliwości, dobroci, miłości. Czy pozwalam się porwać myślom, które jest moje miejsce? Czy chcę służyć? .

Parish Registration

Our parish has the status of a Personal Parish, which means that only the person who declares their will to belong to the parish is considered a parishioner.

Every Sunday, participation in masses, or the fact of living in the parish is not synonymous with belonging to it.

In addition, the fact that someone in our parish has participated in the premarital teachings, married or baptized a child does not mean automatically belonging to the parish, because in our community there are weddings and baptisms of people outside the parish.

Each parishioner can receive several certificates by Registering to a particular community and organizing all the procedures related to the sacraments, for example:

- Baptism or the Sacrament of Marriage
- Receive certificates to be a confirmation sponsor or wedding witness.
- They may also receive permission to be baptized or baptize their own child in another parish (for example, in their respective Countries)
- Permission to marry in another parish.


