

Arrangements must be made at least six months to a year with one of the Priests.




Dear Padre

September 29, 2024

After we die and go to heaven, will our guardian angel still be with us? Will we know the angel in a closer way?

"The existence of the spiritual, non-corporeal beings that Sacred Scripture usually calls 'angels' is a truth of faith" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 328). The notion that each person has his or her own guardian angel may be based on Jesus' warning not to despise "little ones" because "their angels in heaven always look upon the face of my heavenly Father" (*Matthew* 18:10). Saint Basil wrote, "Beside each believer stands an angel as protector and shepherd leading him to life." How might we interact with these constant companions in heaven? In heaven, we'll be consumed with the presence of the beatific vision—the immediate knowledge of God, which the angelic spirits and the souls of the just enjoy. In beholding God face to face, we find perfect happiness. "This perfect life with the Most Holy Trinity—this communion of life and love with the Trinity, with the Virgin Mary, the angels and all the blessed—is called 'heaven.' Heaven is the ultimate end and fulfillment of the deepest human longings, the state of supreme, definitive happiness" (*CCC* 1024). Even though "this mystery of blessed communion with God and all who are in Christ is beyond all understanding and description" (*CCC* 1027), to imagine the pure joy of being close to our guardian angel is just a foretaste of what heaven will be! ●

Registración a la Parroquia

Nuestra parroquia tiene el estatus de Parroquia Personal, lo que significa que solo la persona que declara su voluntad de pertenecer a la parroquia es considerado un feligrés.

Todos los domingos, la participación en misas, o el hecho de vivir en la parroquia no es sinónimo de pertenecer a ella.

Además, el hecho de que alguien en nuestra parroquia haya participado en las enseñanzas prematrimoniales, se casó o bautizó a un niño no significa pertenecer automáticamente a la parroquia, porque en nuestra comunidad hay bodas y bautizos de personas de fuera de la parroquia.

Cada feligrés puede recibir varios certificados por medio de Registrarse a una comunidad determinada y organizar todos los trámites relacionados con los sacramentos, por ejemplo:

- El bautismo o el Sacramento del matrimonio.
- Recibir certificados para ser padrino/a de confirmación o testigo/a de boda.
- También pueden recibir permiso para ser bautizados o bautizar a su propio hijo/a en otra parroquia (por ejemplo, en sus respectivos Países)
- Permiso para casarse en otra parroquia.



Jeśli zatem twoja ręka jest dla ciebie powodem grzechu, odetnij ją; lepiej jest dla ciebie ułomnym wejść do życia wiecznego, niż z dwiema rękami pójść do piekła w ogień nieugaszony. Oto Słowo Pańskie



To, że Jezus już dokonał dzieła odkupienia człowieka na krzyżu, i to, że człowiek jest zbawiony za darmo, nie oznacza, że ma nic nie robić i nie troszczyć się o współpracę z łaską odkupienia. Nie może to być na zasadzie lenistwa duchowego. Trzeba rozumem poznać to, co Bóg w Jezusie Chrystusie dla mnie zrobił, a wolą podejmować decyzje o współpracy z łaską. Czyny ludzkie mogą być naznaczone grzechem i sam Jezus w dzisiejszej Ewangelii mówi o konsekwencjach takich czynów. Wpierw mówi: „Kto by się stał powodem grzechu dla jednego z tych małych, którzy wierzą, temu byłoby lepiej uwiązać kamień młynski u szyi i wrzucić go w morze”. Potem Jezus mówi o tym, co może być powodem grzechu: ręka, nogą, oko; i lepiej je stracić, niż żeby były powodem grzechu i wrzucenia do piekła, w którym nieustannie doświadcza się czegoś nieprzyjemnego. Sam Jezus używa określenia: „gdzie robak ich nie umiera i ogień nie gaśnie”. Jaki jest mój wkład w dzieło mojego zbawienia? Jak współpracuję z łaską Boga?

Parish Registration

Our parish has the status of a Personal Parish, which means that only the person who declares their will to belong to the parish is considered a parishioner.

Every Sunday, participation in masses, or the fact of living in the parish is not synonymous with belonging to it.

In addition, the fact that someone in our parish has participated in the premarital teachings, married or baptized a child does not mean automatically belonging to the parish, because in our community there are weddings and baptisms of people outside the parish.

Each parishioner can receive several certificates by Registering to a particular community and organizing all the procedures related to the sacraments, for example:

- Baptism or the Sacrament of Marriage
- Receive certificates to be a confirmation sponsor or wedding witness.
- They may also receive permission to be baptized or baptize their own child in another parish (for example, in their respective Countries)
- Permission to marry in another parish.


